The Community Action Partnership of San Bernardino County Food Bank serves over 50,000 hungry persons each month. A network of over 180 affiliate food distribution partners including as non-profits, churches, schools, soup kitchens, and senior centers distributes nutritious food and serve meals to those in-need. Food commodities are provided through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), corporate donations, salvaged food from supermarkets, and food drives.
